In this novel event, five boys from each school were to pull a sixth boy standing in a crouched position on a sliding board. The board was fitted with upright hand-holds on the front. To this five boys were hitched with ropes and two cross poles. Three boys pulled on the front pole and two on the rear pole. The team was to run for a 100 yard straight away and return. This race was the hit of some of the big army and navy meets during WW I. This event was held in the first year of the 1920 PCL Track and Field Meet.
